



Connect to Sustainability, Manage Your Surplus Food Ecosystem

The Sustainability Ecosystem™ integrates food rescue operations, reporting & municipal oversight.

Through a city or county-sponsored relationship, qualifying nonprofit pantries meeting defined operational and compliance standards may use the Sustainability Ecosystem™ at no cost.

The system gives pantries direct control of donor and partner relationships, pickups, volunteers, drivers, routes, and events—closing the food-recovery loop through accountable reporting without unnecessary intermediaries, duplicate records, or redundant work.

Food-Item Management provides a customizable, standards-based structure for identifying, classifying, weighing, and reporting food—supporting consistent, compliance-ready records throughout pantry operations.

Food-Intake records what enters the pantry, where it came from, what was received, its category, quantity and weight—creating one documented entry point from food availability and pickup into pantry operations.

Pantries can use **Food-Intake / Food-Outtake** workflow alone or in tandem with Food-Production & Yield when sorted food needs to be inventoried. This optional layer converts received food into standardized outputs for precise tracking by item, quantity, unit, and weight.

Food-Outtake records what leaves the pantry, how much was distributed, and how the organization directs it into the community.

Through vertical integration, each module generates operational records that feed pantry-management reports and oversight dashboards.
